

With the right upkeep (and a pro when you need one) you'll avoid surprises and protect your peace of mind.





AIR FILTERS EVERY 1-3 MONTHS

A clean filter keeps airflow strong, reduces strain on your system, and improves indoor air quality, which is especially important if you have pets or allergies.



HVAC TUNE-UPS

Just like a car, your HVAC works best with routine care. Seasonal service finds small issues before they turn into breakdowns. Schedule furnace maintenance in the fall and A/C maintenance in the spring.



AIR QUALITY

Your HVAC system helps control dust, humidity, and allergens. Clean ducts and the right filtration keep your home healthier year-round.



AIR FLOW

Don't block supply vents or air returns with furniture, curtains, or rugs. Obstructed airflow makes your system work harder, reduces efficiency, and can shorten equipment life.



If your system turns on and off constantly, it may be oversized, have a thermostat problem, or be struggling with airflow. Catching it early can prevent costly repairs.



MAINTENANCE

Regular checkups extend the lifespan of your equipment, keep energy bills lower, help avoid emergency calls, and validate the manufacturer's warranty.

HVAC 101 REPAIR OR REPLACE



Furnace under 10 years or A/C under 10 years—these units typically still have reliable service left

REPAIR

Furnace over 10 years or A/C 10-15 years—nearing or past their manufacturer's warranty.

REPLACE



Only needs small fixes like a dirty filter, loose wiring, or minor repairs that restore performance.

REPAIR

Has major issues like a cracked heat exchanger, compressor failure, or leaking coils.

REPLACE



Repair estimate is less than the cost of a new unit and the fix is affordable.

REPAIR

Cost of repair relative to the age of equipment is not cost-effective—investing in a new system will help save long term.

REPLACE



Energy usage is steady and comfort levels haven't changed. Your system is still running at a good efficiency level.

REPAIR

Energy usage has risen significantly despite regular tune-ups—the system is wasting energy.

REPLACE



The system heats and cools evenly, maintains your set temperature, and controls humidity well.

REPAIR

Your home has uneven temperatures, the system runs constantly, or you struggle with humidity problems.

HARD WATER CAUSES LONG-TERM DAMAGE

As mineral buildup settles, there's less room for hot water, so you may run out faster, even if your system is working. It also strains your plumbing and shortens the life of plumbing fixtures.



MORE THAN WATER

Your home's plumbing system may also carry natural gas to appliances like stoves, water heaters, and dryers. Have gas lines professionally inspected every year to stay safe. An annual plumbing inspection can identify any issues.



WATER PRESSURE ISN'T JUST ANNOYING

Low pressure could mean a hidden leak or blockage, while high pressure can stress pipes and lead to bursts or fixture damage.



GARBAGE DISPOSAL

ISN'T INDESTRUCTIBLE

Grease, vegetable peels, coffee grounds, pasta, rice, egg shells, meat and bones are all common clog culprits that can lead to damaged blades or blocked drains.



WATCH FOR SIGNS YOUR WATER HEATER IS FAILING

Rusty water, rumbling sounds, and fluctuating temperatures are early indicators. Annual maintenance per the manufacturer's recommendation helps extend the unit's life.



SLOW DRAINS ARE MORE THAN A NUISANCE

If downspouts are clogged or damaged, water can pool near the foundation, leading to leaks, basement flooding, or costly structural damage.

PROTIP

Avoid chemical cleaners—they can damage pipes. If plunging doesn't work, it's time to call a pro.

PLUMBING 101 REPAIR OR REPLACE



A standard tank water heater under 6 years old, or a tankless water heater under 15 years old, with regular maintenance per manufacturers recommendation within its expected lifespan.

> **Sump pump** under 6 years old however may vary based on usage.

> > REPAIR

A standard tank water heater over 6 years old or, a tankless water heater over 15+ years old, is more likely to fail and be less efficient.

> Sump pump over 6 years old.

REPLACE



Minor issues like a leaky faucet, worn washer, clogged aerator, or single fixture replacement.

REPAIR

Major issues like a rusted water heater tank, cracked pipes, corroded fixtures, or multiple leaks—repairs may be temporary.

REPLACE



Repair estimate is less than the cost of replacement and the fix is affordable.

REPAIR

Cost of repair relative to the age of equipment is not cost effective—investing in a new system will help save money long term.

REPLACE



Water is clear and free of metallic taste after flushing lines or replacing a filter.

REPAIR

Rust-colored water, sediment buildup, or persistent odor—often signs of aging pipes or failing equipment.

REPLACE


